What is internet?

1. **Global Network:** The Internet connects millions of devices worldwide for communication and information sharing.

3. **Created by Tim Berners-Lee:** Developed in 1989 by Tim Berners-Lee, the WWW is integral to the internet, enabling global communication and information dissemination.
4. **Global Platform:** It serves as a global platform for interaction, allowing users worldwide to engage with content and resources easily.



How to browse safely?
